
ARE YOU READY FOR THE NEXT STEP IN YOUR FAITH JOURNEY?

STEWARDSHIP, GENEROSITY, & GIVING do not all mean the same thing!

Then what do they mean?

STEWARDSHIP

Is simply the act of being a steward; a respected person entrusted with their master's possessions; a manager. Stewardship recognizes God is the owner and we are His managers. What good things will you do with what the Lord has given you?

GIVING

Is to present voluntarily and without expecting compensation; bestow: providing love or other emotional support; caring; it is an act of abandoning something of value. One can give without being generous.

GENEROSITY

Is an attitude or willingness to sacrifice for the benefit of others personally. Generosity even amidst poverty tests our love for God.

Today, more than ever, there is a great need for us to strengthen our parish so that she can serve as a vital source of support for our community. It is in our parish that people become part of a worshipping and serving community. - Follow along the 40 daily prayer prompts
- Create a daily scheduled time to spend with the Lord in prayer
- Set a timer on your phone to keep a prayer schedule
- Consider listening to a prayerful podcast or rosary while on your daily commute
- During your prayer time, light a scented candle that reminds you of church to amplify the prayer experience (Some ideas are rose, chrism, frankincense scents.)
